<b>Wednesday</b> <b>March 8</b>	<b>"The wonderful, wacky world of books!"</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Be creative and add wacky accessories to uniforms!</li><li>No hats, no face paint, shoes should still follow dress code</li></ul>	<b>Wacky Wednesday</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Dr. Seuss wrote this book using the name Theo LeSeig and it is a reminder that some days are just wacky!</li></ul>
